

# Boy Scout Troop 226

## STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT & COOPERATION

I, the parent/guardian as indicated and signed below, give permission for my child(ren) as members of Boy Scout Troop 226 to take part in all activities; and in doing so agree to absolve the Troop and its chartering organization(s) (Achiever Christian School and First Baptist Church on the Hill) from liability because of any injury to my child(ren) during any Scouting activity.

I understand that Troop 226 does not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to the Word of God, or disrespect to the members of the Troop.

Realizing that my attitude toward the leaders and policies of Troop 226 affect the emotional and academic stability of my child, I will support and uphold the standards of the Troop in every way, and will abide by the discipline and regulations established by Troop leadership.

I hereby authorize Troop leaders to employ such discipline, as they deem wise and expedient for my child(ren) as dictated by the Troop's policy. In the case of extreme misbehavior, I understand that a Troop leader will contact me immediately.

At no time will I participate in destructive criticism of the Troop leadership with my child or other persons. I will instead, if a problem arises, go directly to the Troop leader (Scout Master or Committee Chairperson) in a biblical manner, as indicated in Matthew 18:15-17.

I understand that it is the policy of Troop 226 to accept boys of any race, color, nationality and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to boys in Troop 226. Troop 226 does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, nationality, and ethnic origin.

I understand that continuing membership in Troop 226 is predicated upon my child's acceptable behavior at all scouting meetings, activities and events. I understand that if my child's behavior becomes a chronic problem, his/her membership may be terminated.

I understand that Troop 226's role is to work in conjunction with the home to mold students to be Christ-like. On occasion, the atmosphere or conduct within a particular home may be counter or in opposition to the biblical lifestyle the Troop teaches. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, sexual immorality, homosexual sexual orientation, or inability to support the moral principles of the Troop. In such cases, the Troop reserves the right, within its sole discretion, to refuse membership of an applicant or to discontinue membership of a scout.

I give permission for Troop 226 to use pictures of my child in various advertising and promotional material.

I hereby authorize and grant the Troop 226 leaders a limited power of attorney for the sole and exclusive purpose of providing for and authorizing, on my behalf, emergency treatment for medical conditions that might arise and for which I may not be available. I further agree to absolve Troop 226, its leadership and/or its chartering organizations of any and all liability that may arise from their use of such emergency services.
